Quotes from pupils (Please let us know anything interesting, surprising or wonderful which came out of the interviews with pupils)	I spoke to 1 Y5 pupil who said that he enjoyed RE and that he had watched a story about Moses and role-played the story. He role-played the Christmas story and enjoyed acting out the innkeeper. He said pupils learn 'loads of stuff' that we don't learn about in other lessons and they talk about feelings and emotions in the story characters.
Please make a summative comment about RE in the school which may be used for publicity	What came across so strongly was the passion for RE from the subject leader. The Headteacher talked about the subject leaders high standards in the teaching of RE and learning for pupils and her support of others. She was described as an excellent subject leader for RE. Highlights for the school are visitors to talk about their faith where children sit in awe and when they couldn't stop asking questions, Christmas Week where pupils learn about the real meaning of Christmas and awe and wonder seen in the faces of the pupils when they visited the Anglican and Catholic Cathedrals in Liverpool.
